

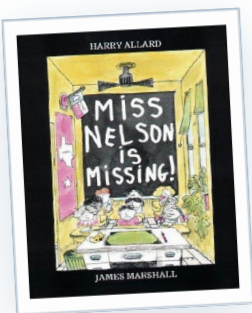
MISS NELSON VS. MISS SWAMP

WHAT IS A VENN DIAGRAM?

A Venn diagram is a diagram for comparing two things. Each circle represents one topic with a list of details unique to it. Features that apply to both items go in the middle where the circles overlap. On the next page, the left circle is where you write things to describe Miss Nelson. The right circle is for Miss Swamp. Things they have in common go in the middle.

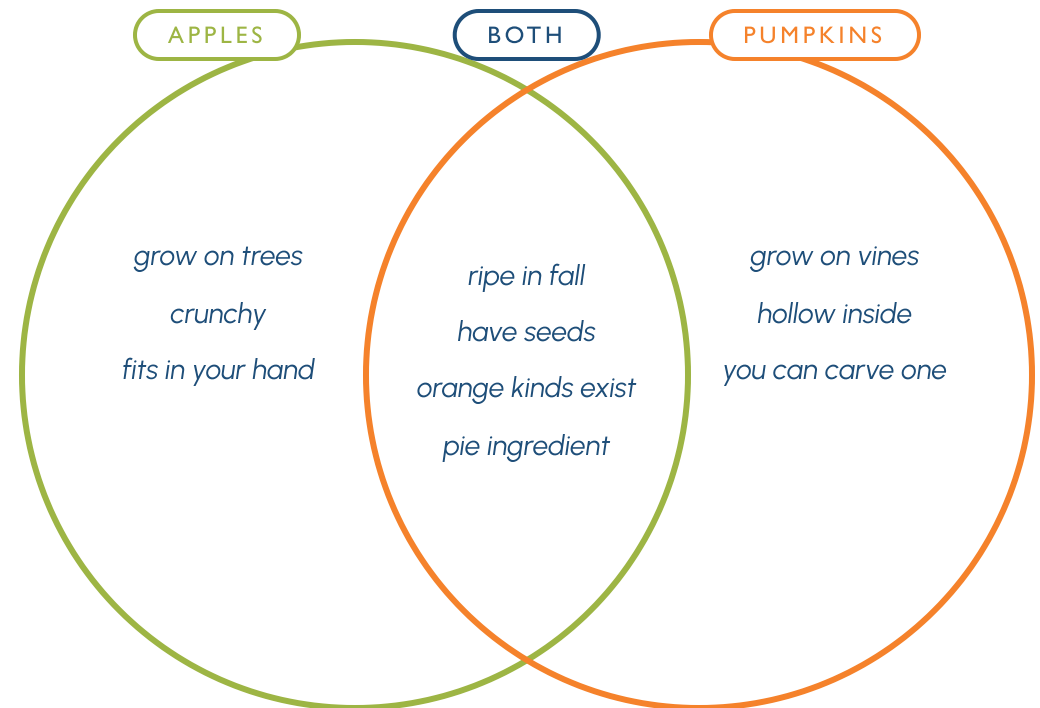
THINGS TO THINK ABOUT
